NOTICE OF MILL VALLEY PARKS AND RECREATION COMMISSION PUBLIC HEARING TO CONSIDER AMENDING THE BAYFRONT PARK MASTER PLAN

The Parks and Recreation Commission entertained public comment at the May 12, 2010 meeting and is seeking further public input in assisting to evaluate and make a recommendation to the City Council on amending the Bayfront Park Master Plan at the June 9, 2010 Parks and Recreation Commission meeting. The request is to consider allowing scheduled games on the Passive area (now limited to practices only), reconsidering the specified number of teams allowed on Hauke South, earlier game start times and adding limited scheduled Sunday use on Hauke South.

The Parks & Recreation Commission will consider public input obtained prior to and at the hearing at which time the Commission will make its recommendation to the Council. The hearing will be conducted by the Commission in the City Council Chambers, 26 Corte Madera Ave. on Wednesday June 9, 2010 at 7:30pm or as soon as thereafter it can be heard.

All persons interested are encouraged to appear and be heard or submit written statements at or prior to the hearing.
