Sewer Service Fee Credit

Recently the City of Mill Valley mailed a postcard notifying residents that beginning this year the City is offering a sewer service fee credit to single-family home owners who qualify for the PG&E California Alternate Rates for Energy Program (CARE). The sewer service fee for a parcel occupied by a qualifying customer may receive a credit of 25%. This credit does not apply to apartments, rental units on the property or businesses. The sewer service fee is collected on the property tax bill which is mailed in the fall.

In order to apply for this credit, please present your PG&E bill indicating participation in PG&E CARE to the City's



Finance Department located on the 2nd floor of City Hall at 26 Corte Madera Avenue, Mill Valley. In order to qualify, the PG&E bill must be addressed to the same property owner and street address for which the sewer credit is requested. <u>Proof of qualification must be presented to the Finance Department by September 5, 2011 in order to receive a credit for 2011/12 taxes.</u>
