## Mill Valley Municipal Code:

- <u>2.08.150 Emergency Preparedness Commission</u>. A. Establishment. The Commission shall consist of seven members, at least six who shall be residents of the City of Mill Valley. One member may be a person residing outside the city limits, but within the boundaries of the Mill Valley School District.
- B Duties and Responsibilities. The Emergency Preparedness Commission shall assist the City in preparing for, responding to, recovering from and mitigating a disaster. The Commission's duties include but are not limited to:
- 1. Identify and organize community groups, including residential neighborhood associations, schools and businesses.
- 2. Promote community emergency response training.
- 3. Create and maintain a Doctors' and Nurses' registry
- 4. Educate residents on ways to be self sufficient in a disaster.
- 5. Make recommendations to the City Council on preparedness matters.
